

MAUREEN MCKENNA GOLDBERG

Doctor of Business Administration in Criminal Justice Management

Senior Associate Justice Maureen McKenna Goldberg of the Rhode Island Supreme Court has devoted her career to public service in the state. She was appointed to the Rhode Island Supreme Court on July 9, 1990 and the Rhode Island Supreme Court on May 30, 1997, the third woman in Rhode Island history to achieve such a position.

Goldberg enrolled at Providence College in its first class of women. After graduating with honors from Providence College in 1973 and Suffolk University School of Law in 1978, she began her professional career as a prosecutor in the Rhode Island Office of Attorney General and rose to the rank of administrator of the criminal division. In 1984, she entered private practice at Goldberg Law Offices, but continued serving the state and its municipalities, frequently on a pro bono basis, until her appointment to the Superior Court in 1990 and the Rhode Island Supreme Court in 1997.



Goldberg holds active memberships in local, state and national bar associations and is dedicated to the improvement of the law and the delivery of legal services. She also has devoted her time, as a board member to philanthropic, educational and rehabilitative institutions in Rhode Island. She is on the board of trustees of her alma mater St. Mary Academy — Bay View, and was on the board of directors of the Rhode Island Foundation from 2003 to 2012.

Goldberg enjoys reading, gardening, spending time with her 15 nieces and nephews, and boating with her husband, Attorney Robert D. Goldberg.
