Faculty exchange promotes international professional development for faculty from Johnson & Wales University and its exchange partners worldwide.

Johnson & Wales University is a private, nonprofit, accredited institution with approximately 9,200 graduate and undergraduate students at its two campuses in Providence, R.I. and Charlotte, N.C. The Providence Campus is the original and largest campus, with close to 6,000 students.

An innovative educational leader, the university offers degree programs in arts and sciences, business, culinary arts, education, nutrition, hospitality and technology. Its unique model integrates arts and sciences and industry-focused education with work experience and leadership opportunities, inspiring students to achieve professional success and lifelong personal growth. The university's impact is global, with alumni from 125 countries pursuing careers worldwide.

FACULTY EXCHANGE PARAMETERS

Exchange is supported by multiple departments across Johnson & Wales University.

To build as much collaboration and flexibility as possible into the exchange, faculty travel dates between the two institutions do not have to be simultaneous. JWU can welcome a guest faculty during one part of the academic year and send a JWU faculty to the partner institution during another part of the year.

The exchange could also involve multiple academic colleges and schools. For example, JWU would be happy to host a Management guest faculty while sending a Travel Tourism faculty to teach overseas.

Each guest faculty is invited to indicate which of the two Johnson & Wales University campuses they would like to join. The office of JWUGlobal is based in Providence. If an exchange is requested with the Charlotte campus, JWUGlobal will facilitate the request and confirm the campus' ability to host.

DEFAULT MODEL

Currently, JWU operates on a 16-week semester schedule during the fall and spring academic year. We also invite faculty who are interested in virtual options and who wish to undertake guest cameos to complement student learning.

Weeklong visiting international lecturer:

Any time during October/November, March/April, or June/July.

A detailed itinerary will be coordinated according to the expertise and lecture topics offered by the visiting faculty.

The lecture schedule will vary and examples include:

- visiting two to three different courses (and multiple sections of those courses) to introduce a new perspective.
- visiting one to two courses multiple times (and multiple sections of the same course) to develop a deeper discussion.

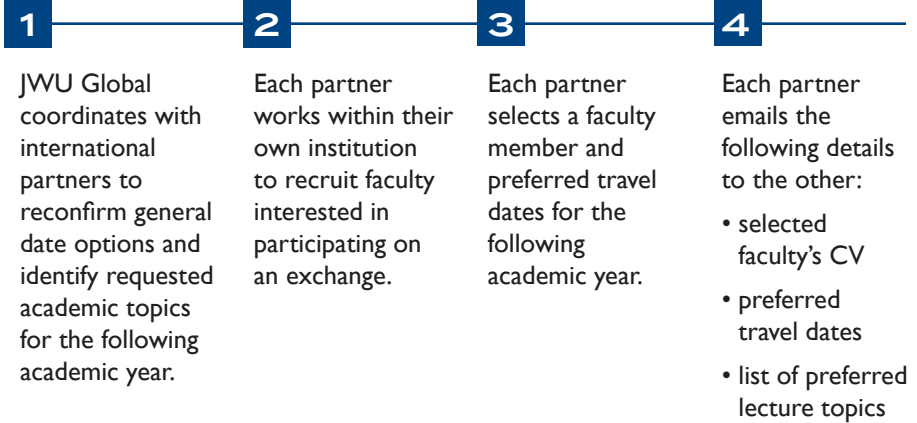

PREFERRED FACULTY SELECTION TIMELINE



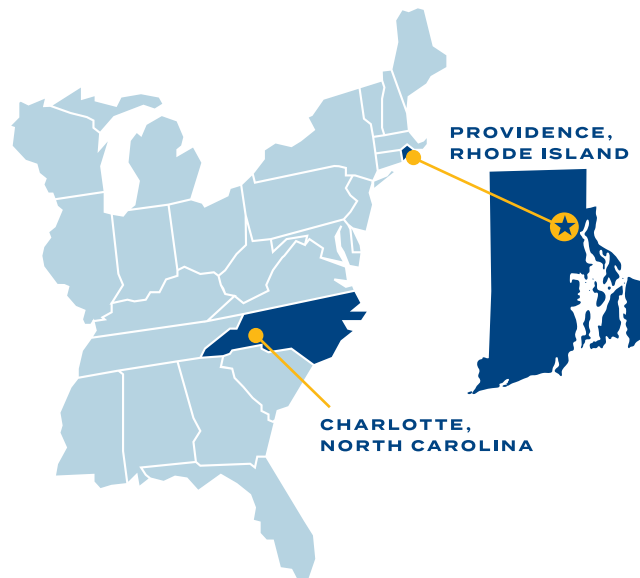
COSTS & LOGISTICS
