Instructors can use the Needs Grading page to organize grading workload. The following assignments can be reviewed and graded: Individual or group assignment attempts, test attempts, blog and journal entries, wiki page saves, and discussion forum posts.

Instructions

1. In the Course Management area of the course menu, click on **Grade Center**. A drop down menu appears. Click on **Needs Grading**.



 On the Needs Grading page, decide which criteria you wish to grade by. You can choose categories, items, user, or by date submitted or a combination of all of these. Once selections have been made, click Go.
