# How to Obtain a Driver's License/State ID

#### 1. You will need:

- A valid passport, visa and I-20
- Your most recent I-94 (You can print it out at <a href="https://i94.cbp.dhs.gov/I94/consent.html">https://i94.cbp.dhs.gov/I94/consent.html</a>)
- An Enrollment Certificate from JWULink
- A valid Social Security Card or **Denial Letter** from the Social Security Administration
- A Student ID Card from Johnson & Wales University
- 2 Proof of Residency. For e.g. Bank statement, Utility bill (gas, electric, cell phone), etc.
- A \$26.50 fee to take the Written Exam. Get the Driver's Manual from the DMV Office or download from <u>http://www.dmv.ri.gov/documents/manuals/Driver\_Manual\_FINAL.pdf</u>

## 2. Go to DMV office, present your documents, pay fees and take the written exam
