

# How to Obtain a Driver's License/State ID



## 1. You will need:

- A valid passport, visa and I-20
- Your most recent I-94 (You can print it out at <https://i94.cbp.dhs.gov/I94/consent.html>)
- An **Enrollment Certificate** from JWULink
- A valid Social Security Card or **Denial Letter** from the Social Security Administration
- A Student ID Card from Johnson & Wales University
- 2 Proof of Residency. For e.g. Bank statement, Utility bill (gas, electric, cell phone), etc.
- A \$7.50 fee to take the Written Exam. Get the Driver's Manual from the DMV Office or download from [http://www.dmv.ri.gov/documents/manuals/Driver\\_Manual\\_FINAL.pdf](http://www.dmv.ri.gov/documents/manuals/Driver_Manual_FINAL.pdf)

## 2. Go to DMV office, present your documents, pay fees and take the written exam

By Bus: From Kennedy Plaza, take Bus No.21 (bus stops in front of DMV)

By car: Take I-95 South, Exit 14B to RI-37 West

Take Exit 2A onto RI-2 South/ New London Avenue

Make a U-turn at Garden Hills Parkway
