On Wednesday, May 4, 2022, at approximately 01:25 AM, Campus Safety & Security (CS&S) responded to the corner of Weybosset Street and Eddy Street, across the street from Gaebe Commons for the intentional burning of a trash can. The Providence Fire Department was notified and immediately responded to the area and extinguished the fire.
