Frequently Asked Questions

When do I have class?

- First-year students do not have to worry about making their schedules. The placement test will determine what classes you take in your first semester.
- Classes are offered Monday through Thursday each week during the academic year, with the exception to University holidays. See the 'Important Dates' page for more information.
- If you have questions about classes, talk to your academic advisor and check jwuLink for your schedule.

What if I do not like my classes?

- There is a DROP/ADD period during the first two weeks of the semester.
- You may also withdraw from a course, until the respective withdrawal deadline. See the 'Important Dates' page for more information.

What are my dining options?

- Options include traditional All-You-Care-To-Eat dining and two mobile order locations with 24/7 vending featuring hot/cold meals. (See page 15)
- We encourage you to text the dining team at 704.727.4616 with all your questions, comments, or suggestions.

How do I do my laundry?

- You can pay with a credit card or with the CSCPay mobile app. The laundry units do not accept change.
- Laundry is typically \$1.50 per load. Prices can vary based on load size.

Where can I access printers?

- You can access printers in the Library, Cedar Hall North and South, Wildcat Den, Computer rooms in the Academic Building, and the 4th floor of Gateway Village.
- All students receive a \$75 printing credit that is available each semester. (It is \$0.10 a page.)
